



Admission/Enrollment

- An Open House will be held on a Saturday in January. Teachers will be available to meet children and parents and answer questions.

All staff members are certified in CPR and First Aid, and are required to take continuing classes in Early Childhood Education.

A Typical Day

- Arrival- Settling in with friends & Fine motor skills
- Circle Time- Group sharing, Stories, Language and Songs
- Centers-Free choice of Art, Science, Math, Blocks, Dramatic Play and Creative Exploration
- Clean-up Time- All children Participate in putting the room in order
- Music Time- Records, singing, instruments, movement and acting out dramatics
- Snack Time- Snack is provided by families on a rotating basis
- Book Look & Story Time- Exploring library books and listening to stories
- Outdoor Time-Games, activities and free play time on the playground
